"7/12 Extract" will be made free of loan for farmers

- The land ownership documents of the farmers will be made free of the loan on it.
- All landless labourers will receive a pension of Rs.500 per month after the age of 65.
- Farm loan will be distributed at 4% interest rate per year.

FOR A HEALTHY MAHARASHTRA

- "Jeevandayi" scheme, introduced during the Shivsena-BJP rule in the state will be made more liberal and implemented effectively by conducting free surgical operations for the poor and at subsidized rate for the middle class patients in all private and government hospitals in the state.
- Health awareness of the common man will be increased by different methods.
- All the vacancies in the health department will be filled up.
- A special system will be introduced so that injured persons in accidents or in natural calamities will be given medical help first and legal formalities will be completed after emergency medical help in all government and private hospitals throughout the state.
- A new scheme will be introduced so that all major cities like Mumbai and all district capitals of the state will have a facility of "ambulance in 30 minutes."

- "SHIVJEEVAN" scheme will be introduced so that every house will receive pure drinking water.
- "SHIVJEEVAN PEYAJAL" scheme will convert 'sea water' into potable drinking water for Mumbaikars.

AFFORDABLE HOUSES FOR "SONS OF SOIL"

- A scheme of a house for Rs. 75000/- in rural area and an apartment for Rs. 500 000/- in cities will be formulated.
- For a total "slum free" Maharashtra, every one will be provided an affordable

house.

SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT OF WOMEN

- Total implementation of the plans for social and economic empowerment of women.
- The government will invest money in the name of every girl child at the time of her birth and she will receive an amount of Rs. 1 lakh when she attains the age of 18 under the "LAADAKI LEK"(Dear Daughter) scheme.
- Each woman member, who is a member of "Mahila Bachat scheme", will get a monthly pension of Rs. 500/- after she completes the age of 65 years.

YOUTH - OUR BASE, OUR FUTURE

- All youth belonging to needy families will get a loan at 4% interest per annum for higher education, depending on the annual income of their family.
- The 'Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme' will be introduced in the urban areas also.

AN ACTION PLAN FOR A PROSPEROUS MAHARASHTRA

- All delayed new railway lines will be completed in a time bound programme with the co-operation of Railway Board.
- Work on new highways between Mumbai-Nasik, Mumbai- Konkan, Nasik-Sambhajnagar-Nagpur and Pune-Nasik, will be started and completed rapidly.
- All roads in the state with high traffic density, will be expanded to four lanes.

VISION 2014 FOR MUMBAI

- The acute problem of old and dilapidated buildings in Mumbai will be solved as per recommendations of the "Afazalpurkar committee" appointed by the Sena-BJP government in the state.
- Substantial financial help to all mill workers who have lost their jobs and accommodation due to closure of mills in Mumbai.

- Bandra-Worli sea link will be extended up to Nariman Point as per our original plans.
- Underground railway lines and roads will be built to overcome the acute traffic problem of Mumbai.

FOR WORKERS IN UNORGANISED SECTOR

- “Urban Employment Scheme” will be introduced on the lines of Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme.
- Daily wage earners like 'Hamals', maid servants, cycle Rickshaw pullers, Hand cart pullers, and employees in small shops and establishments and all workers not covered under 'Gumasta Rules' and all other workers who do not get benefit of old age pension will be brought under a new comprehensive pension scheme to assist them in their old age.
- Special Act will be introduced for all labourers in sugarcane cutting activity and transport business in the state.

REHABILITATION OF SICK INDUSTRIAL UNITS

- "On the spot help" will be introduced to help all small, medium, and large scale sick industrial units in the state.
- A new scheme will be introduced for all successful big industrial enterprises to adopt and rehabilitate sick units in the state.
- To encourage the industrial activities we will abolish Octroi and Toll Tax laid on industrial units in metropolitan corporations, particularly in corporations of 'D' categories.

SOCIAL JUSTICE FOR PROGRESS OF MAHARASHTRA

- 100 % grant for construction of toilets of best quality throughout the state to stop the contamination of underground water resources.
- Easy process for getting caste and Income certificates from the government offices.
- Ownership rights to persons of scheduled tribes who are tilling the government land.

EMPLOYMENT AND SELF EMPLOYMENT SCHEMES

- Strict implementation of government rule for 80% skilled and unskilled jobs for local in all government and private establishments.
- Traditional artisans in rural area (Balutedars) will be given loan at 4% rate to modernise their occupations / Special benefit schemes for "differently abled" persons in the state.
- Systematic implementation of the schemes to help the 'differently-abled'.

FOR THE POLICE PERSONNEL

- A new plan to provide permanent accommodations, education and training of police personnel.
- A special grant of Rs. 25 lakhs and priority in service to the children of police personnel & Soldiers of Maharashtra who have laid their lives for the Nation.

FOR PRESTIGE AND HONOUR OF MAHARASHTRA

- The proposed grand memorial of Shivaji Maharaj in Arabian sea near Mumbai will be completed within 5 years.
- A "Shiv Shrishti" complex will be built at a suitable location in a sub urban area of Mumbai.
- A new Act will be introduced for the effective use of Marathi language in the state. A "Marathi Week" will be organized from 21st February (World mother tongue day) to 27th February (World Marathi Day) every year.

FOR SENIOR CITIZENS

- Government of Maharashtra had enacted the law to fix the responsibility on the immediate descendants of senior citizens for their maintenance and for their well being in their old age. The Shivsena-BJP government will effectively implement the Act.
- "Ajoba-Aji" parks will be built in all towns under municipal areas.

FOR THE UPLIFTMENT OF ART, SPORTS AND CULTURE

- To preserve the rich "Warkari" tradition, Warkari Bhavans will be built in every district place of the state.
- Substantial financial help to all sports persons who will be selected for national and international sports competitions.

TOURISM

- New Shivshahi rule will not permit any industry that is not eco friendly.
- A separate ministry will be created to keep a watch on all the projects introduced by Shivashahi government.
- Maharashtra will be the first state government to introduce a law to recall the elected representatives who do not pay attention to the development works for the benefit of public.
- The Chief Minister of Shivashahi government will have direct contact with general public by video conferencing and other modern methods.
- Second stage of e-governance will be introduced so that the common man need not visit Mantralaya repeatedly.

Dear voters,

Maharashtra experienced a wave of enthusiasm and vitality the moment the election dates were declared. The common man feels that the moment for which he was anxiously waiting is now in sight.

The state witnessed the rule of the 'SHIVSENA-BJP' combine from 1995-1999. During our rule we took bold decisions to transform Maharashtra into a progressive and rapidly developing state and the state ranked at the top among all the states of India then. Besides the Krishna Valley Project, funds were also provided for many other promising schemes were launched in Vidarbha-Marathwada. The government ushered in a tanker free state. Fifty-five flyovers were built for the convenience and welfare of the citizens in Mumbai. There were riots in important cities as well as district places.

According to us this election is similar to a war. It is a war of independence for the people of Maharashtra. Freedom is not only sought only from a foreign rule but also from an unjust and atrocious rule by one's own people. Continuous load shedding, of rise in power tariff and ever-rising inflation has created unrest in the minds of the common man against the government. From the urban office goes to the big and small farmers in rural areas, everyone is frustrated with the increasing levels of corruption in public offices increasing number of the educated unemployed, deteriorating law and order and housing scarcity. MY GOVERNMENT – MY PROMISE

7/12 Abstract of farmers will be cleared of all debts

1 When the Shivsena-BJP government comes to power, all unpaid loans

- taken by the farmer along with principal amount and interest will be waived and their ownership documents will be made free of all liabilities.
- 2 Traders who adulterate seeds and indulge in black marketing of fertilizers will face stringent action.
 - 3 The scheme 'IRMA' to take care of all risks in agriculture produces will be introduced.
 - 4 Farmers who suffer due to natural calamities in agricultural production will be compensated fully, taking into consideration his annual income, through farm insurance.
 - 5 A special set up to give correct prices to the agricultural products considering the expenditure of the farm products.
 - 6 The government will offer, proper price to agriculture products on the basis of actual cost of production with 50% more price for farmers as per the 'Swaminathan Commission.'
 - 7 While introducing any new Legislative Bill in the State Assembly its effects on the farmer will be clearly stated and taken into account.
 - 8 All court case filed against the farmers who have participated in agitation for the benefit of farmers will be withdrawn.
 - 9 Lands under cultivation by farmers will neither be taken for the purpose of SEZs, nor will the government allow any private party to take such land for other purposes.
 - 10 Special provision in the annual state budget for providing Irrigation

facilities. To collect and preserve rain water One Lakh Ponds will be constructed every year through Employment Guarantee Scheme.

- 11 Sufficient financial provision in annual budget of the State to help animal husbandry, poultry, silk worm farming for silk and fisheries.
- 12 To protect the landless labourers from exploitation, the annual income of every landless labourer will be protected by law and they would be awarded a monthly pension of Rs. 500/- when they attain the age of 65 years.
- 13 New modern and scientific eco-friendly technique will be Researched, Developed and put to use for land cultivation.
- 14 A simple and transparent system will be introduced to keep up-to-date land records of every farmer to eliminate the malpractice of change in land records to eliminate corruption in the system.
- 15 A comprehensive survey will be conducted of all farmers with small landholdings to keep 5% reservation for their children.
- 16 Free seeds, fertilizers and Agriculture equipments to small land holders.
- 17 All pending applications for electricity connections of farmers will be given electricity connection within a year. Every application of electric connection will be sanctioned within one month from the date of application.
- 18 Farm loans will be sanctioned at 4% rate of interest per annum.
- 19 Special encouragement for natural fertilizers from bio-degradable

materials.

- 20 For a regular and sufficient supply of fertilizers, the storage capacity of fertilizers will be increased.
- 21 Subsidy, within one month, for farmers who adopt sprinkling and drip irrigation system.
- 22 All incomplete Irrigation Schemes in the state will be completed within 3 years.
- 23 Food for animals will be provided under controlled prices.
- 24 A chain of cooling plant stations for preserving the milk produce will be constructed.

24 HOURS ELECTRICITY SUPPLY AT AFFORDABLE RATES

- 1 All existing power projects will be modernized so that they will run with full capacity. Power projects under construction will be completed with speed. Production of electricity based on Ethanol, Bio-gas and Non-conventional methods will be used to increase power production.
- 2 Maharashtra will be made free of load shedding.
- 3 Heavy electricity transmission loss and theft, will be brought under control.
- 4 The electricity rates across the State of Maharashtra will not be allowed

to increase abnormally.

- 5 The single phase system in electricity transmission will be completed 100%, immediately.

ALL ESSENTIAL ITEMS FOR LIVING WILL BE MADE AVAILABLE AT A REASONABLE RATE

- ◆ The rampant corruption in public distribution system will be eliminated by introduction of “food stamp” method. In this system coupons of fixed prices will be distributed to the people, which they can exchange for day-to-day Household essentials items from any shop of their choice. By this revolutionary method common man will get the benefit of essential items at reasonable rates.
- ◆ All the traditional break-fast food items like “Wada-Pav”, “Misal”, “Thalipith”, “Pohe”, “Puran Poli” will be made tax free.
- ◆ In the regime of Shivsena-BJP rule in 1995-99, the government had kept prices of 5 essential household items, fixed for 5 years. The same Scheme will be re-introduced and the prices of 5 items namely, Wheat, Rice, Turdal, Ground nut oil and Sugar, will be kept fixed by giving financial help to the producers. By coordinating the two schemes, the common man in the state will be protected from Inflation.

FOR EDUCATED AND POWERFUL MAHARASHTRA

- 1 Free education for the girls up till graduation.
- 2 Committed to give compulsory and free education to all boys & girls up to Xth standard, so that Maharashtra will be 100% literate.
- 3 The government will introduce new educational policy which will make revolutionary changes in education and examination methods and make them modern, liberal, practical and job oriented.
- 4 Use of computers in school education, and 'Career Guidance' in education of Sports, Art & Vocational Education.
- 6 The interests of students appearing for S.S.C. Examination will be fully protected.
- 7 Schools running on permanent un-aided basis will be given government grants. The government will have strict control on the fee rise in private schools and colleges.
- 8 A special scheme to protect the right to education of the differently abled students will be introduced.
- 9 Schools in rural areas will be provided with Teachers and other basic Amenities.
- 10 A Merit List of educational Institutions will be prepared on the lines of NAAC. Successful educational institutions / principals / teachers will be given benefits.
- 11 Counseling centers for parents & students to reduce school dropouts in

- urban and rural areas & to provide job oriented education.
- 12 A professional Internship scheme to be launched for students wishing to intern with the Government on various committees and backdoor offices.
 - 13 Reduce the weight of school bags of primary school children.
 - 14 Modernization of IIT to implement mechanisms & adoption schemes whereby successful IIT candidates will be accommodated by top industrialists.
 - 15 Special schemes to improve the standard of public education in Zilla Parishads, Nagar Parishads & Municipal Corporations.
 - 16 1 lakh teachers would be recruited from the present 'Shikshak Sevak' depending on the requirement.
 - 17 Fill up vacancies of the professors & principals.

FOR A HEALTHY MAHARASHTRA

- 1 Operationalise Trauma centers on major roads considering the increasing number of road accidents.
- 2 The scope of 'Jeevandayi Scheme' launched during the Shivsena-BJP reign to be made broader and to provide for free surgical operations for the poor and at subsidized rates for the middle class.
- 3 To implement 'Navasanjeevan' Scheme effectively to prevent malnutrition of children in Adivasi areas.

- 4 To provide Govt. aided 'Health Insurance Scheme' for all.
- 5 Mobile dispensaries will be provided across the State.
- 6 Govt. Medical Colleges & Dental Colleges will be established in Konkan & Mumbai.
- 7 Special Mechanism will be implemented in Govt. & Private hospitals that will provide immediate first aid in case of accidents & then complete the legal formalities. Accordingly, changes will be made to the police regulations.
- 8 To encourage doctors to visit rural areas, Post-Graduate courses will be implemented in districts and priority will be accorded to local medical graduates.
- 9 Testing centers will be immediately established at revenue divisions to control epidemics such as Swine Flu, Malaria and Dengue.
- 10 A mechanism to be immediately enforced whereby ambulance service can be provided within half an hour in Mumbai & developed towns & districts.
- 11 The foundation of Public Health to be strengthened by implementing a three pronged strategy of Pure Water – Closed Gutters – Disposal of Waste.
- 12 New Centers for research and development in the field of medicine and health care will be set up and funded.

- 13 100% immunization programme for Infants.
- 14 To increase the health awareness.
- 15 To fill up the vacancies in health services.

WATER IS LIFE !

- 1 Shivshahi drinking water scheme whereby Mumbaikars will be provided desalinized sea water.
- 2 Shivjeevan Scheme in the state by providing adequate pure drinking water.
- 3 River purification scheme to be implemented in Maharashtra on the lines of Ganga Purification Scheme.
- 4 Privatization of drinking water and farm water will not be allowed.
- 5 Maharashtra will be made tanker free.
- 6 A dynamic programme of preserving Village ponds, farm ponds & rainwater harvesting.
- 7 To provide drinking water for every village, The Government will also provide loans for the 10% amount collected from the public.
- 8 A project to establish a mechanism for perfect management of heavy rainfall in Mumbai, Konkan & Western Maharashtra & preserving &

directing it to draught prone areas.

- 9 Water purification and supply of pure and sufficient drinking water by implementing improved regional water supply under Jeevan Pradhikaran Scheme.

AFFORDABLE HOUSING FOR SONS OF THE SOIL !

- 10 Lakhs of people in Urban & Rural areas are facing scarcity of housing due to the neglect of housing for poor & middle class in last ten years. They will be provided tenements of 300 Sq.ft. under Rural & Urban Housing Scheme.
- 11 A housing programme in next five years for residents plagued with dilapidated buildings, pending slum development schemes & owner housing problems.
- 12 Schemes providing larger houses free of cost to all old housing complexes.
- 13 Formulating a housing policy whereby flats can be bought at affordable rates by new flat buyers. 75% grant in rural areas & scheme providing 5 lakh tenements in urban areas.
- 14 Transparent and accountable working by uprooting corruption in housing sector.
- 15 It is necessary to provide housing facilities in all cities of Maharashtra like Mumbai. The Shivshahi Govt. had provided houses to many people

through slum rehabilitation scheme. To create a slum free Maharashtra, the Shivshahi Govt. will try its utmost to provide affordable houses to everyone.

ECONOMIC & SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT OF WOMEN !

- 16 Total implementation of Women Development Policy passed during Shivshahi Govt.
- 17 Strict action against crimes on women such as torture, dowry and dowry deaths, female infanticide, kidnapping adolescent girls & forcing them into prostitution and other problems faced by women in the domestic and corporate sectors.
- 18 A scheme will be drawn for social & economic development of women, for their honour & security & to provide them employment opportunities.
- 19 It will be compulsory to mention women's name, along with the men's, while purchasing any property and inheriting ancestral property.
- 20 To eliminate corruption, hoarding, adulteration in ration shops the women's savings group (Bachatgat) will be entrusted the fair price shops. A scheme will be drawn whereby they will be provided loans at the rate of 4% interest.

- 21 Pension of Rs. 500 for members of Women's Savings Group (Bachatgat) who have completed 65 years of age.
- 22 'Dear Daughter' (Laadaki lek) Scheme whereby Govt. will deposit, a certain amount, in the name of the girl child at the time of her birth & she will receive Rs. 1 lakh at the completion 18 years of age.

THE YOUTH - OUR BASE - OUR FUTURE

- 23 According to the national policy all those in the age group of 13 – 35 are youth. Our govt. will provide educational training to such youth.
- 24 The phenomenal fees imposed on medical, engineering and similar studies will be reduced.
- 25 A scheme providing loans at 4% to needy households for pursuing higher education.
- 26 Implement 'Savings Group Schemes' for youth. To provide Contracts to the youth on priority basis in Zilla Parishad, Panchayat Samiti & Gram Panchayat.
- 27 Special training classes for self defense, crisis management will be started by Govt. & Private Institutes against terrorism.
- 28 The Shivshahi Govt. will strive to establish the Indian Institute of Management (IIM) in Maharashtra by following up the matter with the Central Government.

- 29 Rs. 800/- per month will be provided as an assistance allowance for three months while searching for a job.
- 30 An 'Urban Employment Guarantee Scheme', based on the lines of 'Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme', will be implemented.

DEVELOPMENT OF MAHARASHTRA !

- 31 A time bound scheme will be prepared by taking special initiative to complete the pending railway routes with the help of the Railway Board.
- 32 The Shivshahi Govt. constructed India's first express highway between Mumbai & Pune, the pending work of Mumbai-Nasik, Mumbai-Konkan, Nasik-SambhajiNagar-Nagpur, Nasik-Pune Express routes will be commenced & completed on fast track.
- 33 Priority will be accorded to neglected issue of development of Medium sized ports & water transport in Maharashtra. 10 medium sized ports will be started.
- 34 The improvement of roads in all cities & villages on modern lines.
- 35 Quadrupling of district roads having heavy traffic.

VISION 2014 FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF MUMBAI

- 36 A permanent machinery will be established to reduce migration to

Mumbai & the strain on the civic services in Mumbai

- 37 The issue of dilapidated & old buildings in Mumbai will be addressed as per the recommendation of the Dinesh Afzalparkar committee appointed in the Shivsena-BJP regime (95-99).
- 38 Paving the way for the success of the IT sector in Hinjewadi.
- 39 Every slum owner in Dharavi will be provided 400 sq.ft. land for the development of Dharavi & to protect the small industries in Dharavi.
- 40 The dams supplying water to Mumbai city being inadequate dams will be constructed on rivers in Konkan (viz Development of Gargai & Pinjal dams) and schemes will be drawn to divert the water to Mumbai.
- 41 Vision 2014 will be prepared for the all round development of Mumbai, old chawls (BDD & B.I.T), transport & all such issues will be completely solved within 5 yrs by Shivshahi Govt.
- 42 To make airports in Mumbai of international standards equipped with all facilities our govt. will follow up the matter with central govt. & airport authority. The area near airports will be developed on priority basis by rehabilitating the slums.
- 43 Additional FSI will be allotted for the rehabilitation of the displaced by various projects for the total development of Mumbai Viz- Flyovers, widening of highways, metro rail, sea link projects.
- 44 Substantial financial assistance for the rehabilitation of mill workers who have lost their jobs & land.

- 45 Ultimate responsibility will be entrusted to the Municipal Corporation as a Controller Authority to bring about co-ordination among various agencies working for development of Mumbai and reduce the confusion.
- 46 The animals slaughtered at Deonar are exported to foreign countries. This practice will be stopped.
- 47 Bandra – Worli Sea Link will be extended till Nariman Point as per the original plan initiated by us.
- 48 Initiative will be taken to establish a second airport for Mumbai.
- 49 Multi-storeyed sub ways & railways to solve traffic congestion.

FOR WORKERS IN THE UNORGANISED SECTOR

- 1 A comprehensive Act for workers in Unorganized Sector, securing their rights.
- 2 To put an end to the contract labour that adversely affects the salaried workers & bringing about a policy for protecting the interests of the workers.
- 3 A pension scheme to assist in old age for unorganized workers Vendors, household servants, cycle-rickshaw drivers, workers on daily wages, cart pullers, workers in small shops & other insecure section of the society.
- 4 A special Act to protect the interest of the cane cutters & transport workers.

REVIVAL OF SICK INDUSTRIES !

- 5 Infrastructure and other facilities will be made available on the spot for a large number of big & small industries on verge of closure in Maharashtra.
- 6 Cancellation of octroi & toll tax for the industrial department of Maharashtra & especially 'D' class Municipal Councils. Such a tax exists only in Maharashtra.
- 7 A machinery will be established to combine the raw material available locally along with craftsmanship carried over for generations.
- 8 A scheme will be enforced whereby the youth interested in entrepreneurship will be provided land/plots at a concessional rate by acquiring the plots of closed industries in MIDC.
- 9 A scheme will be enforced incorporating new rules & concessions to enable the big successful private entrepreneurs to revive the sick industries.

SOCIAL JUSTICE

- 10 100% grants for creating facilities for best toilet blocs to prevent contamination of ground water.
- 11 A follow up action will be taken up with the Central Govt. to create a separate third schedule in the constitution for the progress of nomadic & denotified tribes. Insistence for the implementation of the recommendations of "Renake Commission."
- 12 Schemes to absorb the Adivasis in the mainstream by providing them a source of livelihood and planning of forest & barren land for Adivasis.
- 13 Ownership rights to Adivasis on the land they till.
- 14 Youth interested in self employment will be provided loans, land and capital within a month.
- 15 Loans at 4% rate of interest to traditional Balutedars in rural areas.
- 16 The procedure of providing caste & income certificates to be simplified.
- 17 Funds will be reserved in proportion to the population to make schemes promoting individuals & collective progress of the Dalits more effective.
- 18 The tax impressed on Offerings (Prasad and raw material needed for purchase of food) offered to devotees & poor at different religious places, muths, temples, prayer halls, will be cancelled. Concessions to be given to such institutions.
- 19 Special priority in providing land to the landless under the govt. policy on landless unemployed.

20 To reduce the number of households below poverty line by increasing per capita' income of all. The Shivshahi govt. will implement special schemes to improve the financial power of the adivasis, dalit, nomadic tribes, denotified tribes, OBC's in Maharashtra.

BETTER SCHEMES FOR THE PROGRESS OF DIFFERENTLY ABLED CITIZENS!

21 To accord the fundamental human rights to differently abled & provide them reservation in govt. & private sector.

22 A separate department in Mantralaya for differently abled.

23 An Assistance schemes with detailed planning for the differently abled.

THE POLICE, JAWANS AND JUDICIARY !

24 Twice promotion in service to raise the morale of constables in

police service.

25 A security board will be established by appointed retired police officers to provide security to the industries.

26 Modernization of existing and construction of new police stations for Mumbai & other developed cities.

27 Specific duty hours for the police force to make them efficient & vigilant by providing the best weapons & equipments. Increased number of youth will be recruited in the police force & the number of police on patrol duty will be increased.

28 Appropriate schemes to be implemented to provide housing education training and other facilities for the families of policemen.

29 A Tiger Force consisting of ten thousand reserved police to be stationed at metros like Mumbai, Pune, Nasik with the assistance of ATS/Medical Services Dept./Security forces to prevent cross border terrorism & terrorism from coastal areas.

30 Assistance of Rs.25 lakhs for the families of police & jawans who have scarified there lives while performing their duty.

31 Jai Jawan scheme to be implemented taking into account the needs of ex-servicemen in Maharashtra.

32 Everyday hundreds of court cases are increasing the number of pending cases in the courts of Mumbai. For speedy disposal of court cases 200 new courts in Mumbai will be established. 3 to 5 new courts per district depending upon the number talukas in every district.

EMPLOYMENT AND SELF EMPLOYMENT !

- 33 Strict implementation to ensure that 80% of the jobs are assigned to local skilled & unskilled unemployed people.
- 34 Priority to industry based on the lines of the plant developed at Shirdi that generates gas & electricity from garbage & drainage waste to provide employment opportunities to the youth as well as preserve the environment.
- 35 For the speedy governance in the state thousands of new posts in the government will be created. Institutes giving special training for these jobs will receive special grants from the Shivsena BJP government.

FOR THE HONOUR OF MAHARASHTRA !

- 36 Daily worship of the statue of Shivaji Maharaj at Raigad.
- 37 The work of authorized biography of Shivaji Maharaj, started under the guidance of famous historian Datto Wamen Potdar, will be completed. This biography of Shivaji Maharaj will be declared as an

authentic book on Shivaji Maharaj.

38 The plan to erect grand memorial of Shivaji Maharaj in the Arabian Sea near Mumbai will be executed in 5 years. A special Shiva Shrushti memorial will be constructed at a suitable place in suburbs of Mumbai. A 'Flame of Freedom' will be built with scriptures of Swatantryaveer V.D. Savarkar.

39 To preserve sanctity of religious places and forts in Maharashtra strict steps will be initiated.

40 Flows of river, like Oshivara, Poisar, Dahisar in Mumbai will be rearranged and cleaned on the lines of the Mithi river operation. Similarly many rivers in Maharashtra like the Godavari river, which are the symbols of culture and social heritage of Maharashtra, will be cleaned on the lines of Ganga river purification programme within first 3 years of Shivsena-BJP regime.

41 Central Government observes "Hindi fortnight" to increase use of Hindi language and distributes prizes for propagation of Hindi. Our government will celebrate Marathi week, every year from 21st February (World Mother Tongue Day) to 27th February (World Marathi Day)

42 Facilities will be provided to appear for competitive examination in Marathi languages conducted by different government, semi government and private organization.

43 As per the Act of 1964 for conducting all the work in Marathi for all state and Central Government offices, of which only 50% work is completed till date. Our government will take all the efforts to make 100 percent accomplishment in this regard.

44 Translation Corporation” will be created so that there in no hindrance in the progress of Maharashtra because of total use of Marathi in every field. All modern knowledge is available in languages like German, French, Russian. This modern knowledge in different languages will be translated in Marathi by the “Translation Corporation” A special financial amount of Rs.200 crores is readily available which is not used by the previous government. After coming to power Shivsena- B.J.P government will open the doors of modern scientific medical and technical knowledge of translating it into Marathi.

FOR SENIOR CITIZENS – THE GOLDEN CITIZENS !

45 The idea to have minimum one “Senior Citizen Home” in every district will be executed with full facilities. Special financial aid will be given to these Senior Citizen Homes.

46 Maharashtra Assembly had by an Act, put the responsibility of maintenance and care of Senior Citizens of to the descendants of these citizens. The Government will strictly implement this act.

47 Special help centers will be established to help the Senior Citizens for implementing insurance, pension and health facilities for the

old.

48 Ajoba-Aji (Grand father-Grand mother) parks will be built in every town coming under municipal jurisdiction.

49 Special facilities and security arrangement at all public places for Senior Citizens.

ART, SPORTS AND CULTURE !

50 'WARKARI BHAVAN' in every district place in the state to preserve the rich ancient culture of "Vitthal devotees".

51 To preserve the Culture of the scheduled and nomadic tribes a cultural centre in the name of "Freedom fighter Umaji Naik" will be established.

52 To preserve and encourage dramatic art, both prose and music, encourage sports academy on the lines of P.L. Deshpande academy will be established in every district place of the state. Similarly centres with reference library for music will be established.

53 Full economic help to all sports persons who will be eligible to participate in National and international sports events.

TOURISM

- 3 Tourism of all kinds like sea tourism, adventure tourism and also religious and medical tourism will be encouraged in the state so that Maharashtra will have a place of honour on the tourism map of the world.
- 1 International "Sea World" in Mumbai with all the aquatic creatures.
- 2 Reserved sanctuaries will be developed of natural forest with an aim for Ayurvedic medicines. A special drive to give remunerative prices to the products made by persons belonging to Scheduled Tribes in the state leading to medical tourism.

- 4 A special Fort tourism will be encouraged by developing 350 historic forts in the state to attract history loving tourists from India and also from Abroad. Students, professors and professionals would be on the committee to develop tourism.
- 5 All famous religious places, and other important places where devotees gather for religious ceremonies will be provided 'Maharashtra Bhawans' with all facilities like, affordable accommodation, meals and sanitation facilities.
- 6 The policy declared by forest department to protect forests and to encourage forest tourism in places like Bhimashankar, Melghat, Toranamal etc. will be implemented immediately.

TO PRESERVE FORESTS AND FOREST PRODUCTS

- 9 Subsidy will be given to farmers, who plant trees of 'MOH' wine from the flowers of Moh trees and edible oil from fruits of Moh tree will be provided earning for schedule tribes. Special facility and encouragement to grow medical trees like "JETRAF" and others on barren lands of the state which will also help to produce Bio-diesel for the Industry.
- 10 The work of constructing small soil dams to preserve water will be taken on large scale as per the policy of "stop water flows and preserve them underground".

- 11 “Policy of Redevelopment” of forests which are not properly developed will be undertaken to give employment to unemployed youth.
- 12 Nurseries of medical plants started by forest department will be redeveloped with the local public participation to encourage Ayurvedic system.

FOR GOOD GOVERNANCE

- 13 Shivshahi government will not permit any project that is not Eco-friendly.
- 14 Shivshahi government will not allow cultivated land to be used for other purposes
- 15 Permission of Mumbai Municipal Corporation will be made compulsory for any project by the Central Government.
- 16 Special Task Force to protect the land reserved for any government, semi government or projects of public interest.
- 17 Special Ministry to monitor the projects promised in the manifesto of Shivsena-BJP alliance.
- 18 A review will be undertaken of all projects carried by the government. A time bound programme will be decided by committee of members of state assembly. No new committees will be appointed while reviewing these projects. Projects which are out dated will be either closed or amended as

per requirements.

- 19 At present, 27 different corporations started by the State Government have incurred a loss of Rs. 5560 crores. The corporations which have become liabilities and created financial distress to the state will be reviewed and out dated corporations will be closed.
- 20 Our government will be very careful in utilizing the financial help offered by the Central Government. Every effort will be made to implement the rules and regulations in running projects sponsored by the Centre. Regular review will be taken of centrally aided schemes so that no fund given by them goes back for non implementation of the scheme.
- 21 A special progress book of every Minister who heads the Ministry will be maintained. A time table of every scheme given in Our Manifesto will be decided within 3 months and review of each scheme will be taken every year.
- 22 A guarantee letter for 5 years will be made compulsory for every Contractor who undertakes the work of development projects and Highways in State. If the quality of this work is found to be of inferior quality within a period of one and half year, or the beneficiaries of Welfare project are distressed by the project, heavy fine will be imposed on Contractors. The license of repeated offenders of this clause will be revoked.
- 23 A special bill for, first time in the country, will be introduced to call back the elected representatives who neglect the development project and different public Welfare Schemes initiated by the State.
- 24 A scheme will be introduced for the Government Employees who neglect

their duties or who do not execute the Welfare Schemes under their authority will face stringent action, while the employees who complete and execute the schemes successfully will be rewarded.

- 25 The Chief Minister of Shivsena-BJP alliance will have direct dialogue with the people through Video-Conferencing and other modern day facilities.
- 26 A second stage of E-governance will be introduced in the government department, so that the common man need not visit Mantralaya repeatedly.
- 27 Our Government functioning will be transparent, accountable and will cut down on the unnecessary expenses.

OTHER

- 28 All students and youths from poor and lower middle class community of Maratha Caste who do not get benefit of reservation will come under special reservation category, strictly on the basis of their annual income.
- 29 A special well planned suburban area will be developed around 10 important cities in the State.
- 30 A special scheme introduced for people affected by various government

projects, will give land, financial compensation, maintenance grants, training, actual partnership in the developed projects, a piece of developed land, free house, water and other facilities.

- 31 A special financial help of Rs. 1000/- to every person below poverty line to open his bank account.
- 32 All ownership rights of the land will be regularized.
- 33 Money for payments against subsidy, pension honorariums will be deposited in the bank on the first date of the month.
- 34 Pune Airport will be named as 'Bal Gangadhar Tilak Airport'.
- 35 A new act will be introduced to cancel Driving licenses of all drivers who repeatedly violate R.T.O. rules.
- 36 A special scheme will be introduced to reduce road accidents in the State.
- 37 A special project will be prepared to make public transport system which will not pollute the environment.
